Harborview Road from Melbourne Street to I-75 Public Information Workshop

Fort Myers, FL - The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District One, invites you to attend a public information workshop about the Project Development and Environment (PD&E) study to widen Harborview Road from Melbourne Street to I-75 in Charlotte County.

The public information workshop will be from **4 p.m. to 6 p.m. (open house format) on Thursday, March 29, 2018 at the Charlotte County-Punta Gorda Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Building, 25550 Harborview Road, Meeting Rooms A-B, Port Charlotte, FL 33980.**

FDOT is studying the proposed widening of Harborview Road from two to four-lanes to improve connectivity between US 41 and Interstate 75, enhance safety along the corridor, and improve emergency evacuation in Charlotte County. Additional right-of-way is needed to accommodate widening Harborview Road and for stormwater management ponds. Existing access to properties along Harborview Road will change due to the addition of a median, a result of widening the road.

The meeting will be an open house format with a continuous video presentation. Project staff will display plans and answer questions about proposed improvements to Harborview Road from Melbourne Street to I-75.
